## EXPECTATIONS FOR THE DECIDUOUS SEASON

We want to take this opportunity to thank you for your valued support during the citrus season. It was certainly challenging, yet a record 145m cartons of citrus were inspected and certified amidst the unprecedented business environment. A significant number of cartons have been inspected and processed using electronic platforms like TITAN 2.0 and e-Cert. Various stakeholder engagement sessions have been held over the past weeks in preparation of the coming deciduous season. As agreed during the engagement sessions, we wish to clarify the following for the coming season:

- The DALRRD's E-Inspect of the e-Cert system will be available for clients that are not on TITAN 2.0. PPECB Inspectors will use this standalone system to ensure inspection results are available in the Trade Unit Register. Note that electronic certification cannot be facilitated through the use of this platform.
- The PPECB Manual Inspection System will not be available for the deciduous season.
- TITAN 2.0 version 2 will be the only electronic inspection system used in addition to e-Cert.
- Electronic Export Certificates will only be available via TITAN 2.0, otherwise manual Export Certificates will be issued

Discussion are still being held on the expectations for the 2021 season and will be communicated early in 2021.
